Pingle Lane

We have had news that our neighbours who are developing the Pingle Lane plot of land will be closing the style for 3 weeks as of Monday 9th March. This will block entrance to the school land via Pingle Lane. If this is your usual journey to/from school you can reroute by coming along past Long Row school and then walking through their car park (remaining on the footpaths) and then over the footbridge. This may affect your family when coming to Parents' Evenings later this month. Long Row School have very kindly given their permission for this to be used over the 3 week period the style will be closed. **Gates being locked**

Thank you for helping us to keep our children safe and understanding the gates are for safety reasons. As well as being locked during the day, they will be locked each night between 4-4.30pm. There will be exceptions such as parents evening, concerts and performances.

Parking during morning drop off

You can drop children off from 8.35am onwards; Kidzone is available if you need to drop off earlier due to work commitments. If you need to park to be able to go into school please use the top playground, (this will be locked at 9am). Otherwise, come up the drive on the left hand side, use the turning circle to face your vehicle down the drive and use the car doors on the pavement side to get the children safely into the playground. This should keep the flow of traffic going. Please be mindful that respect needs to be shown to all users of the drive, it is a private drive and can be used by the builders/owners of the private property that used to be the Convent.
