### Key Knowledge

- Ash Wednesday marks the beginning of Lent.
- Lent lasts for 40 days and purple is used.
- On Ash Wednesday, a cross is made on our foreheads with ashes, showing we want to grow more like Jesus. The ashes are made by burning palms from Palm Sunday last year.
- Lent is a time to try to change and live like Jesus. Lent is a time to pray, to give up something and to do something good.
- Palm Sunday is the beginning of Holy Week.
- On Palm Sunday we remember Jesus riding into Jerusalem on a donkey. The people waved palm leaves and shouted, "Hosanna!"
- Good Friday is a day we remember that Jesus died on the cross.
- On Easter Sunday we remember that Jesus rose from the dead. We call this the Resurrection. God the Father gave him new life.
- Easter Sunday is a happy day; the priest wears white (a sign of new life).
