## Key Knowledge

- In **Advent** we **wait** and get ready for Christmas – Jesus' birthday.
- The Advent **Wreath** is an evergreen circle with 3 purple candles and 1 pink candle. The candles represent the 4 weeks of Advent. Each week another candle is lit.
- The Angel Gabriel visited Mary.
- Mary loved God so much that she agreed to be the Mother of Jesus.
- Mary visited her cousin Elizabeth.
- Elizabeth was waiting to have her baby, John.
- Jesus was born in a stable in Bethlehem.
- A messenger from God visited the **shepherds** to tell them that a special baby had been born. They hurried to see Mary, Joseph and the baby Jesus.
- The Christingle helps us understand love and why he sent Jesus to be the light of the world.
