Dear Parents and Carers,

I hope that you have all had a great summer holiday. It's been wonderful to see how quickly the children have settled back into school life. Our new reception class children have been incredible and seem so settled at school, we send a warm welcome to the children and their families. Education Sunday

This Sunday (12/9/21), we celebrated Education Sunday – One of the oldest days of special prayer in England and Wales! Nearly 200 years ago, the Catholic Church in this country was a mainly poor and immigrant community and education was seen as the best way of sharing faith and improving people's lives. The Catholic Church made the education of the poor their top priority and so they started raising money to fund the national network of schools which we enjoy today. Today the Catholic Church is the largest provider of secondary schools and second-largest provider of primary schools in the whole country!

Meet the Teacher Evening – Wednesday 15th September

On Wednesday 15th September, we shall be hosting an event for parents online to come and meet their child's class teacher and to find out more about our curriculum and priorities for the year. The event is less formal than the Parents' evening, lasting around half an hour, but is equally as informative. The meetings will also be recorded and saved in the MS Teams files (just as lessons were during lockdown), so if you are unable to make the meeting you will still be able to access the information.

The first half of the meeting will be delivered via a pre-recorded video for you watch, which will be the class teacher updating you all on our curriculum, routines and key information for this year. This will be sent out to you on Tuesday 14th for you to watch at your convenience.

Then you will have the opportunity to enter a MS Teams meeting with your child's class teacher and some of the other parents from the class. This will take place on Wednesday 15th September. Please use your child's stu.eli.srscmat.co.uk email for this event (again, just as you did during lockdown). For parents of reception class, your child has a class email and our office will be sending this out to you. The class teacher will present on the learning for the term and there will be time for you to ask any questions. If you wish to share any further information with them privately, this may be done via email.

The 'Meet the Teacher' time slots will be at either 4.00pm or 4.30pm. By having 2 different times, this should allow you to speak to two different teachers if you have more than one child in school. The class teacher will schedule a meetina in your child's class team and you will be able to join the meeting from here. Changes to our bubbles regarding the Government's COVID restrictions

During the week 20/9/21 we will be changing our bubble system to two groups within school, a KS1 and KS2 group. The government have issued new guidance and we are no longer responsible for track and trace as the NHS are now





taking on that role in all schools. We will be introducing the children back to dining in the school hall and being able to have playtimes outside together again! How lovely! Just to reassure you we will continue to have all the extra cleaning measures in place that we already do.

The biggest change for yourselves is that we will have KS2 drop off from 8.45am and KS1 at 8.55am and we will begin this on <u>Weds 22nd September</u>.

KS2: The children will come onto the playground and the bell will go at 8.55am for the start of school. Parents can drop off on the drive area, using the turning circle and letting children out of the car and through the pedestrian gate on to the KS2 playground – no parking allowed, or park up in the lower car park on the bend of the drive and let the children walk up the path on the field.

KS1 children can be dropped off 10 minutes later from 8.55 and go straight into their classrooms in order to be ready for lessons at 9.00am. You can park on the top playground, take children to classroom doors and then leave.

Any families with children in both key stages can come for the earliest drop off time and latest collection time and can use the KS2 parking zones.

Collection will be at 3.20pm for KS1 and 3.30pm for KS2, again staggered in order to help with the volume of traffic. The KS2 playground will not be open for parking, instead parking will be on the bottom car park for KS2 and top playground for KS1.

The Ripley and Belper buses will continue to operate, so there will be no parking on the school drive.

With the increased number of families walking to school (as suggested by the government), the children going to Kidzone and the children using the buses we should have slightly fewer cars and so feel we can try this new drop off/pick up. It may take some adjusting and we appreciate your patience in this matter.

As per normal we will still only release children when we see their parents on the playground/waiting area/class door at the end of the day. Y6 children, when you deem it to be the right time and with your written permission being sent into school, are allowed to walk home or from the bus by themselves.
