- Jesus wants us to love one another - we hear this message in the hymn 'A New Commandment'.

<b>home</b>	Where you live with your family.
<b>love</b>	When you really care about someone of something.
<b>family</b>	A group of people related to each other.
<b>Christian</b>	Someone who believes in and follows Jesus.
<b>scripture</b>	A piece of writing from the bible.
<b>St. Paul</b>	He taught people about Jesus, after Jesus' death.
<b>Our Father</b>	We call God 'Our Father' because he is our loving and forgiving Father in heaven.
<b>forgiveness</b>	To <b>forgive</b> does not mean that what the person who has hurt you has done is OK, it means you are ready to heal from the hurt and anger and then mend or move on from your friendship with the person who hurt you.
