Spelling:	Definition:
atlas	A book of maps and charts.
area	Is the amount of space taken up by a 2D shape or surface. We measure area of counties in km²
capital city	A capital city is the most important city in the country and is where the government run the country from.
continent	A continent is a large land mass. The world is split into seven different continents.
country	A country is an area of land with its own government.
culture	A group of people's traditions and beliefs that they practice in their daily lives.
currency	A system of money in general use in a country.
identity	National identity is a person's identity or sense of belonging to one state or to one nation.
landmark	A building or place that is easily recognized, especially one that you can use to judge where you are: The Eiffel Tower is one of the most famous landmarks in Paris.
population	All the people who live in a place.
tourism	People traveling for fun. It includes such activities as sightseeing and camping. Places that people go to for tourism are called tourist destinations.
