Safer Internet Day 2023 - please see power point on age restrictions included in this email

Safer Internet Day is a great opportunity to focus on online safety with your child, whatever their age. There is a range of support to help you start a conversation with your child, whatever that may be about and no matter how much time you have.

Safer Internet Day 2023 is celebrated today, (7th February 2023), with thousands of people across the UK working together to champion youth voice and engage in conversations about how we can all work together to make the internet a great and safe place. We will be doing lots of fun activities across the school throughout this week for Safer Internet Day.

This year, the theme for Safer Internet Day is:

Want to talk about it? Making space for conversations about life online.

With our children of all ages accessing the internet for gaming and socialising, please find a PowerPoint attached to this email as a reminder of what the age restrictions are for some popular apps and online games. Please note that the age restriction is not always due to there being violence or inappropriate images on them. The restrictions are also in place due to the user possibly having access to talking to others online (strangers) and being able to purchase/gamble on the game or app.





Technology and the internet will always be available to our children. Staying safe online is not about saying no to them using it, but rather educating them in using it safely. Many games and apps have parental controls which can be set to restrict access to some games/apps. Below are some useful links to help you support your child in being safe online.

Message from Pastoral Parish Council and Strategy Group

The reason I am sending this message to you is because our parish is facing challenging times. As part of the Catholic family in the Amber Valley our school is a vitally important part of the parish. When the Catholic Church was re-established in England and Wales the instruction was to build schools first and church buildings later. Indeed, for many parishes the school was the place of worship for Sunday Mass for many years. Consequently, anyone connected to the school has a clear link to the parish and we value your contribution to our community. We are facing the situation of there being less priests in the diocese (indeed, across many countries in the western world). This will see the number of services we can hold each Sunday (and throughout the week) reduced. The diocese has identified the issue as being one of declining numbers of clergy, declining numbers of those attending church services, but the same number of buildings. It is time for us to consider what we want the future of our parish to look like now that events are bringing these matters to a head.

Every member of the parish, or those who have a link to it - past, present and future - are invited to come to the meeting we are holding at St. Elizabeth's School on 15 February at 7.00 pm. This is being held at the school to accommodate the largest number possible. The Strategy Group, who have been tasked by the Pastoral Parish Council, will present some possible pathways that we could follow as we look to the future of our parish. There is much that is uncertain, but it is critical that the widest view of the whole parish is taken into account when determining what we do next. This is vitally important; the diocese gave their view of their preferred pathway, but we must determine if this is the right one for us as a worshipping community. It is a time to turn what could be viewed as a misfortune into an opportunity. To make this a reality we need you, the people.
