- The Holy Spirit confirmed the apostles' faith and gave them courage to speak the Good News.
- Philip spoke the Good News of Jesus; he baptised the Ethiopian in the river.
- St Paul used to be called Saul and persecuted Christians until God filled his mind with the light of truth. Then he wanted to do was spread the Good News of God's love.
- St Paul spread the Good News to the Gentiles (people who were not Jews). He would start Christian communities in the towns he visited and write letters to them. Paul's letters show how the Good News is given throughout the early Church.
- We become disciples and <u>receive the Holy</u>
 <u>Spirit in Baptism</u>.
- We believe in the <u>Trinity</u> the Son returns to the Father and sends the <u>Holy Spirit</u>.
