

1. <u>What I know already:</u>

#### 2. <u>What I am going to learn – My Sticky Knowledge</u>

- Egyptians believed they needed to live a life full of good deeds and have a light heart to enter the afterlife.
- The burial of the dead in Ancient Egypt differed depending on wealth and status.
- Know that the ancient Egyptians believed in many Gods and this impacted on daily life.
- The Egyptians were **skilled farmers** and **invented** tools and technology, including **irrigation**, to allow them to produce the food that a **great civilisation** would need.
