Parent Consultation Evenings (including SEND) The app opened for bookings on 14.10.24

We hold these meetings via the School Cloud App and they are booked online, each meeting lasting 10 minutes. If you have any concerns about accessing these meetings, please contact the school office for advice with connecting or booking appointments.

The dates are Wednesday 23rd October and Thursday 24th October. The app will be opened for booking appointments at 4pm on Monday 14th October.

For children with any SEND (Special Educational Needs and Disabilities) we hold an additional night to discuss the targets on the child's APDR (Assess, Plan, Do and Review), this is 20 minutes, still booked via School Cloud but during the booking process parents can decide if they would prefer online or face to face meetings. The date of the SEND review night is Wednesday 6th November, the booking for this will be done on the School Cloud App and also open on Monday 14th October.

As a result of the most common requests in the parent survey we have continued to keep the School Cloud app – you asked- we responded!

Harvest Festival



We will be celebrating Harvest festival on Thursday 17th October in the school hall **at 2.45pm.** At the request of our parents there will be groups of children taking turns to perform songs or a poem, and yes, there will be "Cauliflowers Fluffy" making a return. You asked – we responded!

Any donations for harvest can be sent into school, classes are already making their own class displays, before all the produce comes down to the hall for the festival. Afterwards, the produce will be donated to Hope For Belper, which is a food bank. Please consider donating meals in a tin (eg chilli, big breakfast), tea, coffee, toiletries, nappies etc (the food bank are ok for baked beans at present).

TT Rockstars Day - Friday 18th October

You may be aware that we use an app called "Times Tables Rock Stars", this encourages children to learn their times tables and helps them to prepare for the Statutory Multiplication Test that Y4 complete later this year. In order to re-launch the importance of learning times tables (both in school and at home), we are





having a dress as a rockstar day on Friday 18th October. All fancy dress is allowed – in the past this has ranged from wigs, bandanas, t-shirts, jeans and even blow-up guitar/microphones accessories! Please don't think you need to buy anything new for this day it is simply a lot of fun whilst we re-emphasis with everyone about learning numbers, repeating patterns and that these sequences will help with times tables. In KS1 there is a focus on learning numbers, number sequences and spotting repeating patterns which leads into learning the 2, 5 and 10 times tables. KS2 is the focus for the rest of the times tables and we have found that children who are confident with their times tables are confident with learning maths in school, any support you can give to learning times tables at home would be of benefit.
