#### Parent Consultation Evenings (including SEND)

These will be held in October. We hold these meetings via the School Cloud App and they are booked online, each meeting lasting 10 minutes. If you have any concerns about accessing these meetings, please contact the school office for advice with connecting or booking appointments.

The dates are Wednesday 23<sup>rd</sup> October and Thursday 24<sup>th</sup> October. The app will be opened for booking appointments at 4pm on Monday 14<sup>th</sup> October.

For children with any SEND (Special Educational Needs and Disabilities) we hold an additional night to discuss the targets on the child's APDR (Assess, Plan, Do and Review), this is 20 minutes, still booked via School Cloud but during the booking process parents can decide if they would prefer online or face to face meetings. The date of the SEND review night is Wednesday 6<sup>th</sup> November, the booking for this will be done on the School Cloud App and also open on Monday 14<sup>th</sup> October.





#### **Bishop Patrick visiting St Elizabeth's**

As part of a trip to the area, Bishop Patrick will be visiting St Elizabeth's on the morning of Monday 7<sup>th</sup> October, this is the Feast Day of our Lady of the Rosary. He will be meeting with our Chaplaincy Team and Joe, our Chaplain. He will be leading the children in praying a decade of the Rosary, it's an exciting event as this will be lived streamed not just to every classroom at our school, but to all schools in the Nottingham Diocese!

#### **TT Rockstars Day**

You may be aware that we use an app called "Times Tables Rock Stars", this encourages children to learn their times tables and helps them to prepare for the Statutory Multiplication Test that Y4 complete later this year. In order to re-launch the importance of learning times tables (both in school and at home), we are having a dress as a rockstar day on Friday 18<sup>th</sup> October. All fancy dress is allowed – in the past this has ranged from wigs, bandanas, t-shirts, jeans and even blow-up guitar/microphones accessories! Please don't think you need to buy anything new for this day it is simply a lot of fun whilst we re-emphasis with everyone about learning numbers, repeating patterns and that these sequences will help with times tables.

#### **Oracy Project**

Last year our Y4 and Y5 children were lucky enough to be supported by a local theatre artist to support them with speaking out and having the confidence to do so, therefore improving their oracy skills. This year we have been able to secure this for all classes in school and our artist, Laura Goulden, will be working with every class, staff and also giving career talks to classes. In October, years Reception to Y4 will be meeting with Laura for their career talks.

#### **Harvest Festival**

We will be celebrating Harvest festival on Thursday 17<sup>th</sup> October in the school hall at 3pm. At the request of parents each year group will be taking a turn to perform a song or poem, and yes, there will be "Cauliflowers Fluffy" making a return. You asked – we responded!

Any donations for harvest can be sent into school with classes initially making their own class displays before all of the produce comes down to the hall for the festival. Afterwards the produce will be donated to Hope For Belper, which is a food bank. Please consider donating meals in a tin (eg chilli, big breakfast), tea, coffee, toiletries, nappies etc (the food bank are ok for baked beans at present). Thank you in anticipation of your generosity.
