#### **Dear Parents and Carers,**

Y6 completed their SATs and did so with such a level of maturity, took the tests in their strides and absolutely gave their very best on the days of the tests. We are so proud of all our Y6 children, Miss Holmes was delighted with their attitudes to the tests and their commitment to remaining calm and focused, we would like to say a huge thank you to all parents involved.

A couple of weeks ago our Y5 went on their residential to Willersley Castle to take part in PE, outward bound and adventurous activities. The children showed a huge sense of bravery to the different challenges they faced. They were resilient and encouraged each other to face challenges, their support for each other was wonderful to see first-hand. The entire group were an absolute pleasure to take away and spend time with - this was also noticed and commented upon by the instructors at Willersley Castle! Well done, Y5!

We have had Ofsted Inspectors visit earlier this week for a graded inspection of the school. The visit was rigorous and very thorough, but also very positive. The wonderful news to share at this point is how the inspectors noticed and were very impressed with how articulate the children at St Elizabeth's are and how idyllic their playtimes are. The inspectors now have 18 working days (so half term will not count) to send their draft report to school, then there is a 5-day consultation period and after that the report will be made available to staff, Governors, parents by email and put on the website. #### **Sports Day**

On 4<sup>th</sup> June we are holding our Sports Day which we are hoping will start just after 1.05pm. All children will be involved in sports activities around the football pitch area on the school field and then we end with sprints on the track. The Pingle Lane gate will be open for the afternoon for anyone walking to school (highly recommended due to lack of parking space). The magnetic pedestrian gate at the bottom of the school field will be open from 12.50-1.05pm, anyone arriving after that time will need to come to the school office. Children will need to wear their active uniform for this event.
