Parent Consultation Evenings

Harvest Festival

This year we are collecting donations of food and toiletries for our local food bank called, "Hope for Belper". The children are already bringing their donations into school, and we can see the displays of donations taking shape in their classrooms. Our Harvest Festival celebration is taking place at 3pm on Thursday 16th October in the school hall, everyone is welcome to attend.

TT Rockstars Day!

On Friday 17th October children are allowed to come to school dressed as a rockstar!

This is to support their learning in maths, initially of number patterns and sequences, but then as they are older for their work on times tables – we use the app TT Rockstars (or Times Tables Rockstars) hence the idea to dress as a rockstar. Whilst we understand this is fun for the children, it also reminds them of the importance of learning their times tables. We intend to kick start the day with an assembly in the school hall for all the children to show us their rock star moves and to present Arithmagician awards, this will be led by our maths co-ordinator Ms Fitzpatrick. Secondary School Applications for pupils currently in Y6

The deadline for submitting your application for a secondary school place is midnight on 31st October 2025. Application forms are available on our Local Authority website. <u>Secondary school admissions - Derbyshire County Council</u>

For every Catholic school you apply for if you wish your child to be considered and ranked under a faith criterion you should also complete a supplementary information form and return this form to the <u>school</u> by the deadline, (forms are available from the LA and the school). You MUST also include the supporting evidence as required with this form, e.g. baptism certificate. If you do not have the required evidence, please contact the parish/Church where your child was baptised for a copy certificate in good time. Failure to supply the required supporting evidence will mean your child is ranked in a lower criterion which may affect your chance of a place.
