Dear Parents and Carers,

Welcome to Advent at St Elizabeth's!

It seems to be a busy time of year, both in homes and at school, so here is a quick reminder of the events in school over the next 3 weeks.

Our <u>Jesse tree assemblies</u> began yesterday, Monday 1st December, telling the stories of Jesus and his family back to the beginning. The timings for each daily Jesse Tree are on the calendar of events attached to this newsletter (please scroll down). Parents and families are welcome to join us for any or all of these assemblies.

There is a **Christmas gift sale** for the children on Wednesday 3rd December, this is about giving the children an opportunity to buy a small gift, "in secret" to give as a gift to an adult at home.

Our Christmas disco will be held on Thursday 4th December from 6pm (not earlier due to KidZone using the hall) until 7.30pm, there will be dancing, music (probably fairly loud) and games as well as a sweets/drinks stall so pocket money is a good idea! Please do not feel your child has to attend this - it is an optional event.

On Friday 5th December there is a **non-uniform day** in exchange for anything in a bottle (eg shampoo, wine, fruit shoots, etc). These days are to support the Christmas Fayre stalls.

KS1 Nativity Show, "Lights, Camels, Action 2. The Sequin!" is being performed to the school on Monday 8th Dec, to parents and families at 2pm on Tues 9th Dec and again at 6.30pm on Weds 10th Dec.

The Christmas Fayre is on Friday 12th December starting at 2pm for the children and then 2.30pm open to parents. Please note this is not a leave school early day. When you arrive at school you will be able to go to your child's classroom to sign them out of their teacher's care in order to go "shopping" and visit Santa together.

Monday 15th Dec is the day for our **Christmas jumpers** (or any preferred Christmas outfits!) with the children's **Christmas dinner** and the **panto**.

Choir will be singing for the elderly people at Osmaston Grange Care Home on Tuesday 16th December at 10am.

Advent Mass will be celebrated on Thursday 18th Dec at 10am in the school hall.
