- **God** made our beautiful world and everything in it. **God** made me!
- We make the **Sign of the Cross**: "In the name of the Father, and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit. Amen."
- When **God** had created the world, he said, "Indeed it is very good." (Genesis 1: 31)
- Jesus was **baptised** in the River Jordan by John.
- The whole of **Creation** shows God's love for us (Laudato Si' 84-88).

- We enter God's family, the Church through **Baptism**.

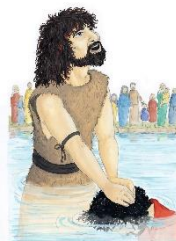


Key Vocabulary and Definitions	
baptism	Baptism is a special welcome to God's family, the Church.
Creation	The world and everything in it, which God has made.
font	The container in a church that holds Holy Water.
God	Our Father in heaven, who created everything. He loves us and knows us.
Holy Water	Special water, which is blessed by the priest, and is poured over the child's head in Baptism.
shell	A seashell is sometimes used to pour the Holy Water as a reminder of Jesus' baptism by John the Baptist.
Sign of the Cross	The sign we make to remind us of what we believe. God gave us his only Son, Jesus, and fills our hearts with the Holy Spirit because he loves us all. 
steward	Someone who looks after God's Creation.
stewardship	Caring for God's Creation.
unique	Special and different from anything/anyone else.
welcome	A warm and friendly greeting.
white garment	Caring for God's Creation.
